



President Liz Johnson and members of the Rotary Club of St Agnes and St Piran 'lit up' Wheal Coates Engine House last evening in support of World Polio Day on 24th October.


The idea was born from newest member Chris Cox who transferred to the club last month. Chris, a two-time Past President himself, had the idea after seeing the article about the 'Nearly Home Trees' being lit up on the Cornish Border at Cookworthy Knapp. He commented 'With all the restrictions in place since the outbreak of Coronavirus it's been difficult for charities such as Rotary not only to meet but to continue its great work serving the community and helping those in need. The call went out from Rotary International to think of something different to mark World Polio Day something that Rotary has championed since 1979 so he thought why not light up something in red, Wheal Coates is iconic in Cornish History, is a major tourist attraction and better still is on our patch'



President of the Club, Liz Johnson was thrilled at the idea and recommended support for the project which was duly taken up by the membership. Chris spoke to a friend of his, Richard Smith, who is the General Manager at Flambards, and very kindly arranged for his team to prepare two powerful LED red lights for the evening. Callestick Farm Ice Cream came up with a generator to power them and thanks to Sebastian and Angela Parker for not only the use but for bringing it all to Wheal Coates and setting the system up.

President Liz Johnson along with Vice President Seb, Rotarians Tom, Freddie, Colin, Ann and Chris posed, socially distanced, for a photo-call with the Wheal Coates Engine lit up in red for the occasion.

As a founding partner of the Global Polio Eradication Initiative, we've reduced polio cases by 99.9 percent since our first project to vaccinate children in the Philippines in 1979.

Rotary members have contributed more than \$2.1 billion and countless volunteer hours to protect nearly 3 billion children in 122 countries from this paralyzing disease. Rotary's advocacy efforts have played a role in decisions by governments to contribute more than \$10 billion to the effort.

Today, polio remains endemic only in Afghanistan and Pakistan. But it's crucial to continue working to keep other countries polio-free. If all eradication efforts stopped today, within 10 years, polio could paralyze as many as 200,000 children each year.

IN THE GARDEN IN DECEMBER

It has been a mild autumn, with many trees still holding on to their leaves until quite late. The days drawing in but the winter solstice is just around the corner (Monday 21st December) so we can look forward to them beginning to draw out again.

2020 has been a very different year with lots of challenges but there have been some rewards too with communities pulling together. Many people have found comfort in the natural environment and in particular their gardens.

You may want to enjoy a well earned rest but December and January are great opportunities to be ahead for the 2021 season.

Jobs For December

- Clear fallen leaves but don't throw them they make a great compost. Don't forget to include your pond if you have one.
- Get in your last cut of the lawn before the new year
- Plant new trees and shrubs. Particularly bare root trees.
- Move tender plants inside or if they are too big protect them.
- If you have a greenhouse ensure the heater is working or insulate it with bubble wrap.
- If you haven't managed to do so already plan your spring lawn care (scarifying, spiking and over sowing) for the spring.
- Transplant deciduous trees and shrubs
- Harvest root crops, cabbages and sprouts
- Prune roses to prevent wind rock. Remember to remove all dead, diseased and damaged stems.
- Order your seeds and plugs plants for 2021.
- Sow broad beans and sweet peas
- For the wildlife friendly garden avoid pruning seeds heads and grasses, and put out bird food to help them over the winter months.
- It is a great time to prepare any planting areas. Dig them over now but leave the large clumps for the effects of the winter to do the work of breaking them down.
- Plant any bulbs, you'll still get a great spring display.
- Top up or lay mulches to help reduce maintenance for 2021!

Protecting Tender Plants

Located in Cornwall it means we don't normally get it as cold as everywhere else so firstly consider what, if any, plants need protection. Also think about previous winter temperatures and how precious particularly plants are to you. It might be worth getting a minimum and maximum thermometer so you can keep an eye on exactly what the temperature is in your garden.

Canna, dahlia, geraniums and tuber begonias can be cut down to 5cm, lifted and stored but most will survive with protection of compost around the base in Cornwall.

Small plants can be lifted and moved inside. Larger plants can be wrapped and protected either with horticultural fleece or bubble wrap.





What is Karma?



REPORT OF THE FULL COUNCIL VIRTUAL MEETING HELD ON MONDAY 09th NOVEMBER 2020

Registered/Non- Registered Interests & Dispensations: MH declared an interest in agenda item 6, planning application PA20/08768 (Seren House)

Cornwall Council Report:

AH advised that the Full Council has agreed that the St. Newlyn East Parish Boundary be changed to include the Strawberry Field land, as previously agreed by St. Newlyn East & St. Enoder PC's. This is subject to the agreement of the Local Government Boundary Commission.

DL asked what the Council's policy on litter collection from holiday properties. DL to email AH with the issue for him to investigate.

It was commented that work has started on the proposed Holiday Park along Scotland Road, even though planning permission has not been granted. AH confirmed that this has been reported to the Council and an investigation is underway.

Planning Applications, Appeals & Decisions:

PA20/09187 Springfield SUPPORT Support with condition that annexe is tied to the main dwelling (P/S: CA/RT. 6 for, 2 against)

PA20/08536 Gwills Cottage SUPPORT P/S: EG/CA

PA20/08768 Seren House SUPPORT P/S: CA/AM. 4 for, 3 against, MH abstained)

The PC confirmed that they agreed with the Planning Officer's decision to refuse planning permission for Starling Barn as Planning in Principle applications are not permissible in Fiddlers Green due to the land being within the Penhale Sands SAC Buffer Zone.

- The decision regarding an EIA for the Saint's Trail has gone to the Secretary of State.
- The Tregerles Farm application that went to Planning Committee was passed. However, some members expressed concern about the purpose of the site and any further applications will be subject to a site visit. PH thanked CA & MH for attending on behalf of the Council

Matters For Discussion:

(a) Recreation Ground – Brushing of the MUGA/Floodlights: The Planning Application for the floodlights hasn't been registered yet as there is some information outstanding. The MUGA brushing took place last week and it seems to have made a difference. RESOLVED: TMS to be asked to brush the MUGA every 6 months.

(b) St. Newlyn East Highway Issues: The posts for the Speed Visor have been installed and the visor is ready for delivery. RESOLVED: Clerk to organise delivery to Braefel Garage. The following issues were discussed (i) The new 30mph sign along Cargoll Road has been very poorly installed and cannot be seen when driving up the road. (ii) The condition of Trewolla Lane is very poor and the potholes need repairing. (iii) The condition of the road between the Trevilson Junction and the Mitchell Underpass is very poor. (iv) The run off from the fields at the back entrance to the Windfarm is causing issues again. (v) The road at the bottom of Cargoll Hill by the pond, urgently needs cleaning. RESOLVED: Clerk to report all issues. EG to send photos of the road at Mitchell.

(c) Adoption of the Amenity Space in Mitchell: CC confirmed that the land can be transferred to the Parish Council. The draft Deed of Transfer has been received and approved & the Clerk is waiting for the final documentation for signing. NOTED.

(d) Empty Property Mitchell: The Clerk has forwarded the photos to CC and is waiting for a response. NOTED.

(e) Installation of a Zip Wire at the Recreation Ground: The order has been confirmed and the Clerk is waiting for an installation date. NOTED.

(f) Footpath between Tinnens Croft & Halt Road: Ocean Housing has confirmed that they own the Footpath & that an adjoining property on Halt Road has historical rights to use that area. NOTED.

(g) Cemetery Trees: No progress. Agenda item next month. NOTED.

(h) War Memorial Refurbishment: AM asked for this to be a January agenda item. Thanks were expressed to Barbara Pearson & her team and the Mitchell Village Association for their wonderful Remembrance displays. RESOLVED: SNE poppies to be stored at Wesley Hall.

(i) Refurbishment of Public Toilet: An advert will be going in the Newsletter this month to advertise the tender. NOTED.

(j) Social Housing in the Parish: It was queried why there is an Ocean Housing property for sale along Nanhayes Row, when more affordable housing is planned for the village. RESOLVED: Clerk to contact Ocean for an explanation.

- (k) Dropped Kerb along Halt Road: It was discussed that the kerb along Halt Road has been dropped to provide parking, but permission has not been obtained. This is unfair to other residents who have applied for permission via the proper channels and been refused. RESOLVED: Clerk to report to enforcement.
- (l) Allotment Issues: VT read out an email from the Allotment Association objecting the plan to put a composter at the Allotments, requesting assistance with the purchase of a rotavator and brush cutter & to ask if the PC's insurance would cover the shed. A lengthy discussion ensued. RESOLVED: Clerk to get quote for a green waste collection. Allotment Association advised to apply for a grant towards the required equipment.
- (m) Mitchell Village Hall: CA advised that the need for a Village Hall in Mitchell is growing. There is a suitable site opposite the Strawberry Farm and the Council should consider funding the purchase of the land and the construction. He asked for a grant of £30,000 to be awarded. It was commented that land has been allocated in the new development at the other end of the village which would be free. £27,500 has already been allocated towards the project. A discussion ensued. RESOLVED: Clerk to contact the Council's Planning Department to get a steer as to whether planning permission would be granted on the site opposite the Strawberry Farm & contact the developer to check if the land on the new development could be transferred to the Parish Council.
- (n) Parish Councillor Vacancy: A discussion took place as to whether to co-opt at the December meeting, bearing in mind that there will be an election in May 2021 & the Council winds up in March. RESOLVED: Clerk to contact the prospective candidates & ask them to submit a brief resume so that co-option can take place in December.
- (o) Methodist Chapel Rent: A discussion had been held via email with regard to a rent reduction for the Methodist Church in light of the Covid 19 Pandemic. Three options were discussed (i) no reduction, (ii) a 50% reduction & (iii) a 90% reduction. It was voted 5 votes to 3 for a rent reduction. A further vote was taken as to the level of the reduction. RESOLVED: Rent reduction of 90% awarded for the September payment only (3 votes for, 2 votes against). CA advised that he felt very strongly on this issue and resigned from the Council. He left the meeting.

Urgent Matters for Discussion incl. any Outside Meetings Attended:

It was discussed that a pond had been illegally dug out at Tregerles Farm. RESOLVED: Clerk to report to enforcement.

AM advised that he had resigned from the PCC

An enforcement case has been opened about the chimney installed at 11 Nanhayes Row.

Correspondence:

Clayre Zolla Use of field for Summer Fayre on 1st Aug 21 RESOLVED: Permission granted.

Mitchell Village Association Help with Remembrance Sunday Funding

RESOLVED: Grant of £50 awarded.

Football Club Carland Cross Grant & Youth Football RESOLVED to agree in principle for the area between the MUGA and changing rooms to be used as a youth football pitch. Clerk to ask Football Club to submit invoices for payment rather than giving the Football Club money upfront.

There being no further business, the Chairman thanked members for their attendance.
