





# **'Food Support'**



### Community Benefit Fund Report - March 2020

Ladock Parish Council has been making grants available to local organisations and individuals for some years. These grants are intended to support areas which improve community life in some way. In 2016 the parish was fortunate enough to receive one-off contributions from local solar power installations which took the fund to a high point of £85,000 and allowed the council to consider a wider range of projects. The council publishes an annual report to help you understand where the funds have been directed.
